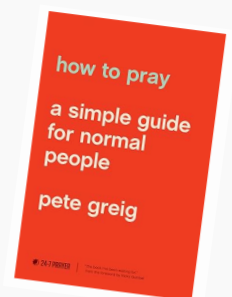
Welcome to the first issue of our quarterly newsletter! We hope this is informative and encourages you to participate in the many exciting opportunities we have planned through the end of 2024.
